[1] Memoranda from counsel are due on 23 October 2023. Issues to be canvassed

include the appointment of pūkenga. I would also like counsel to make submissions

on the possibility of referrals of questions of tikanga to the Māori Appellate Court as

set out in s 99 of Marine and Coastal Area (Takutai Moana) Act 2011. I am aware that

this matter had been raised at an earlier judicial conference.

[2] As the first stage of hearings is due to commence in February 2024, it may be

that any such referral is impractical. However, there may be some utility in

considering a referral for any overlapping claims in southern most part of the hearing

district the second stage of the hearings due to commence in July 2024. In any event,

I would appreciate counsels' views.

[3] An in person pretrial conference of up to a half day is to be arranged for Friday

1 December 2023. A suitable venue in Auckland will be arranged. In exceptional

circumstances, audio visual attendance will be considered.

[4] The agenda will include hearing details such as the order of appearance, the

unavailability of the hearing venue up to four days a month, and the need for

translation so that appropriate arrangements can be made. I am also aware of a minute

recently issued by Walker J concerning a March 2024 fixture for another matter

affecting counsel so ensuring those matters are properly accommodated within the

hearing programme here will be considered. The extent to which evidence may be

taken as read, including both technical and lay evidence, as well as its relevance will

also be discussed.

[5] Finally, I confirm that the case management conference scheduled for 13

October 2023 is now vacated.
