MINUTE (NO 4) OF CHURCHMAN J [Appointment of pūkenga]

[1] In my minute of 10 November 2022, I directed Mr Ferguson to confirm that Dr Joseph was willing and able to accept appointment as pūkenga in the Group M Stage 1(b) proceedings.

The Marine and Coastal Area (Takutai Moana) Act 2011, *Minute (No 2) of Churchman J, Pūkenga appointment*, 10 November 2022.

- [2] Mr Ferguson filed a memorandum on 24 November 2022 confirming that he had contacted Dr Joseph and ascertained that Dr Joseph was willing and able to accept appointment as the pūkenga for the Group M Stage 1(b) hearing scheduled to commence on 12 February 2024.
- [3] In my minute of 10 November 2022, I had directed that any counsel opposing the appointment of Dr Joseph as pūkenga in the Group M Stage 1(b) hearing should file a memorandum.
- [4] Only one memorandum has been received. That was by Mr Naden on behalf of Te Hika o Papaūma. He confirms that his client consents to the appointment of Dr Joseph as pūkenga in this matter.
- [5] No other memoranda commenting on this proposal have been received. Accordingly, Dr Robert Joseph is hereby appointed as pūkenga for the Group M Stage 1(b) hearing.
- [6] Subject to the possibility of amending or adding to the questions that Dr Joseph is required to answer, I propose that they be the same questions as set out in relation to the Group M Stage 1(a) hearing.
