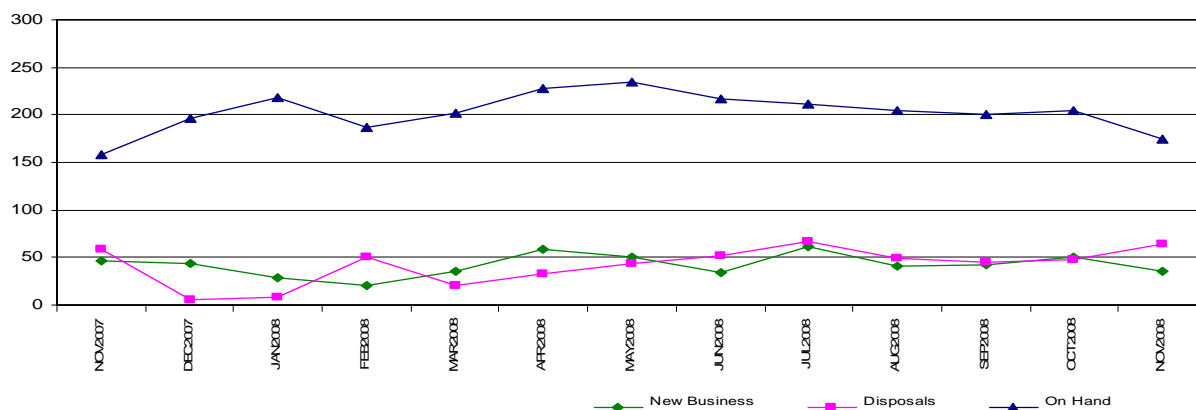


COURT OF APPEAL – NOVEMBER 2008

Court of Appeal: Criminal Appeals



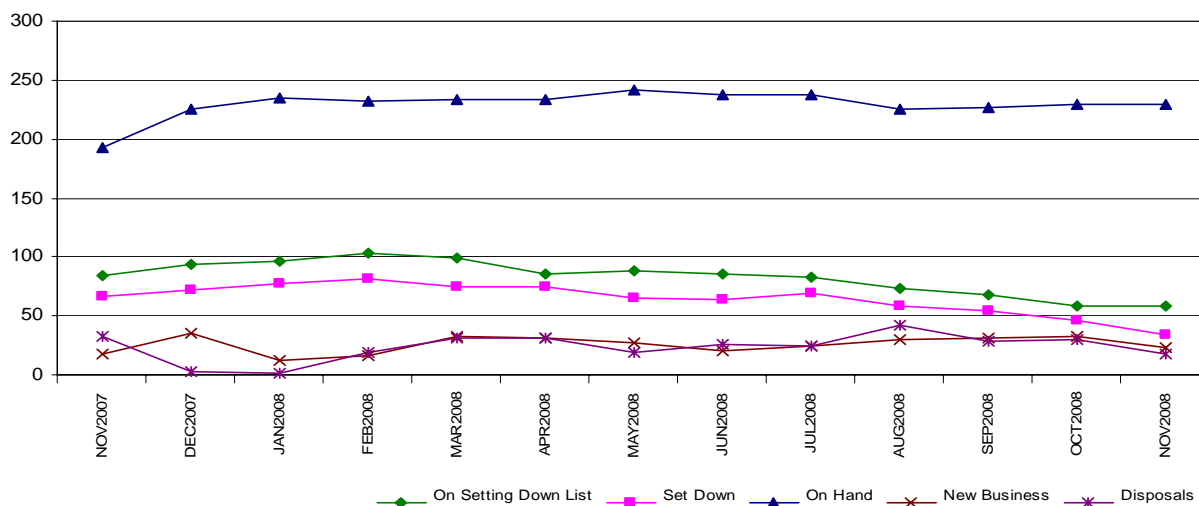
During November 2008, 35 criminal appeals were filed, a decrease of 24% from the 46 filed in November 2007.

The number of appeals on hand as at the end of November 2008 was 175, an increase of 11% on the 158 appeals on hand at the end of November 2007.

There were 64 criminal appeals disposed of in November 2008, an increase of 10% on the 58 appeals disposed of in November 2007.

[Clearance rate for November 2008 = 1:1.82]

Court of Appeal: Civil Appeals



During November 2008, 23 civil appeals were filed, a 35% increase from the 17 filed in November 2007. Eighteen civil appeals were disposed of in November 2008, down 45% from the 33 disposed of in November 2007.

The number of civil appeals on hand at the end of November 2008 was 230, which was a 19% increase from the 193 at the end of November 2007.

Of those 230 appeals, 59 were on the setting down list as at 30 November 2008 – compared to 84 as at the end of November 2007.
