**TELEPHONE CONFERENCE MINUTE OF  
ASSOCIATE JUDGE P J ANDREW**

[1] This minute addresses matters discussed at the telephone conference on Tuesday, 2 March 2021 and in advance of the judicial settlement conference scheduled for 11-12 March 2021 in Tauranga.

[2] Mr Lewis, on behalf of Ngā Potiki a Tamapahore Trust, filed and served a draft agenda in advance of the telephone conference. All parties are in substance agreed with the proposed agenda. I note that Mr Melvin, for the Attorney-General, will discuss directly with Mr Lewis some minor points of detail that require clarification.

[3] There will be a karakia and mihi in respect of both the opening and closing of the judicial settlement conference. The applicant parties are to confer with a view to reaching agreement between themselves as to how the relevant protocols will be observed.

[4] Following the karakia and mihi there will be an opportunity to address housekeeping matters before turning to address items on the agenda.

[5] It is anticipated that discussion about the third part of the agenda will commence before the conclusion of the first day. That is to ensure that there is sufficient time to address important and outstanding issues on the second day of the conference.

[6] In relation to a projector and the possibility of witnesses appearing by AVL, counsel are to consult the Registrar in the first instance.

[7] Mr Lewis is to file and circulate the finalised agenda by **12 noon, Tuesday, 9 March 2021.**
