MINUTE (No. 19) OF POWELL J [Ngā Pōtiki Minute No. 28]

- [1] At the close of the hearing on 2 November Ms Feint, on behalf of all counsel, made a request for an extension for the time for filing closing submissions until 9 a.m. on Monday morning and a delay to the commencement of the closing submissions hearing until Tuesday 9 November 2021.
- [2] As I discussed with Ms Feint the existing filing date had been determined at a point when it was hoped the evidence could be completed by today and was in any event subject to review. Noting that the evidence will not now complete until tomorrow 3 November 2021 at the earliest, as well as the fact that one of the Motiti witnesses has passed away and there will be a tangi on Motiti on Thursday, I accept that it is reasonable for there to be an extension to the filing date for closing submissions.
