CONFERENCE MINUTE (No. 21) OF POWELL J [Ngā Pōtiki Minute No. 30]

- [1] As foreshadowed in [16]-[19] of Minute (No. 20) this conference was convened for the purpose of hearing submissions on four issues that had arisen in the course of closing submissions. The submissions made at the conference will be considered in the Ngā Pōtiki Stage 2 judgment in due course.
- [2] In addition, leave was granted for additional submissions to be filed as follows:
  - (a) to enable Ngāti Whakahemo to reply to the Crown submissions presented in the closing submissions hearing on whether the foreshore of Motunau is included within the certificate of title; and
  - (b) to enable counsel generally to complete or correct cross-referencing of evidence relied upon in closing submissions, with such to be included in separate memoranda rather than through filing updated closing submissions.
