[Withdrawal of unsworn affidavit]**

[1] The Mana Ahuriri Trust was an interested party in the Stage Two Ngāti Pāhauwera hearing.

[2] Mr Lyall appeared for Mana Ahuriri Trust and on 18 May 2022 filed an unsworn affidavit of Tania Eden. That affidavit was provisionally admitted in evidence subject to the requirement that a signed and sworn version would be filed.

[3] No such signed and sworn version has been filed and, on 15 June 2022, Mr Lyall filed an application seeking leave for the affidavit to be withdrawn.

[4] That leave is granted.
