**MINUTE OF HARVEY J  
[Whāingaroa Harbour hearing]**

---

[1] I thank counsel for the memorandum dated 27 February 2026, filed in response to my minute of 13 February 2026 which was issued as a result of the Crown memorandum of 9 February 2026.

[2] Ms Cole submits that the advice in the Office of Treaty Settlements and Takutai Moana — Te Tari Whakatau pānui of 30 January 2026 is different to the content of the Crown memorandum of 6 February 2026. Counsel further contends that the Crown's advice is confusing and in summary asks for a new fixture to be set in the 2028 calendar year.

[3] I have conferred with the registrar and now confirm that a new fixture will be scheduled at the earliest available date in 2028.

[4] The upcoming July 2026 fixture is accordingly vacated.
