2018 Court of Trial Protocol

The Chief Judges of the High and District Courts of New Zealand have a statutory obligation to establish a Court of Trial Protocol.¹

The Protocol lists the classes of offence for which a High Court decision is required as to the court in which the defendant will be tried.

The latest revision of the Court of Trial Protocol has been gazetted and will come into force on 12 March 2018.

The 2018 Protocol adds two Crimes Act 1961 offences to class 1 of the Protocol:

- s 105A Corrupt use of official information and
- s 105B Use or disclosure of personal information disclosed in breach of s 105A.
