## **PUBLIC ACCESS:**

Under the current Court of Appeal COVID Protocol you **must not** enter the Court Building if you are:

- showing signs of illness;
- have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 7 days.

All persons in the Court building (including courtrooms) are **encouraged** to wear a KN95 (or equivalent) or surgical mask.
