MINUTE (NO. 14) OF CHURCHMAN J

[1] On 11 May 2020, I issued a minute noting that the only counsel to have nominated a pukenga was Ms Zwaan appearing for Te Upokorehe. I had not at that stage been provided with copies of the other memoranda that had been filed which addressed the appointment of a pukenga.

[2] I have now reviewed copies of those documents and thank counsel for their suggestions both as to the identity of the pukenga and the role that they will play.

[3] I have assumed that all those whose names have been put forward have consented to act in the role of pukenga. If that assumption is incorrect, I ask that the counsel nominating the various candidates to immediately advise the Court of that fact.
