JUDGMENT OF THE COURT

- A Leave to appeal is granted in respect of the sentence of reparation only.**
- B The approved ground is whether the sentence of reparation complied with the requirements of s 32 of the Sentencing Act 2002.**

REASONS

[1] Leave is not granted for the proposed appeal against the sentence of imprisonment because no arguable question of principle is raised and the effective sentence and the minimum non-parole period were not manifestly excessive. Indeed they were fully justified.
