JUDGMENT OF THE COURT

The second application for recall of this Court's judgment of 20 September 2021 (*Siemer v Auckland High Court* [2021] NZSC 120) is dismissed.

REASONS

The application

[1] On 20 September 2021, this Court dismissed Mr Siemer's application for leave to appeal against a decision of the Court of Appeal which upheld the Deputy Registrar's decision to decline to waive security for costs.¹
