JUDGMENT OF THE COURT

A The application for recall of this Court's judgment of 26 July 2023 (*Dunstan v Bank of New Zealand* [2023] NZSC 89) is dismissed.

B There is no order as to costs.

REASONS

[1] On 26 July 2023, this Court delivered a judgment¹ dismissing Ms Dunstan's an application for leave to appeal against decision of the High Court.²

[2] On 7 August 2023, the applicant filed an application for recall of this Court's judgment.

[3] None of the matters raised by the applicant provide a basis for recall of the judgment. The application for recall is therefore dismissed.
