JUDGMENT OF THE COURT

The application for leave to appeal is dismissed.

REASONS

[1] In a judgment delivered on 28 May 2026,¹ we dismissed Mr Siemer's application for recall of the Court's judgment of 20 March 2025 (*Siemer v Attorney-General* [2025] NZSC 16). The effect of the judgment of 28 May 2026 is that if Mr Siemer wishes to pursue this leave application, he is required to pay the filing fee.² The filing fee has not been paid.
